CHILDREN'S VACCINE FOR 6 MONTHS TO UNDER 5 YEARS OLD

DOSE INFORMATION



As of July 14, 2022, the Moderna Spikevax COVID-19 vaccine (25 mcg) is the first COVID-19 vaccine authorized in Canada for use in pediatric populations under the age of 5 years.

Recommendations

The National Advisory Committee on Immunization (NACI) recommends that children 6 months to under 5 years of age who are moderately to severely immunocompromised may be immunized with a primary series of three doses of the Moderna vaccine, using an interval of 4 to 8 weeks between each dose.



NACI strongly recommends at this time that the Moderna vaccine primary series for children 6 months to under 5 years of age should not be given on the same day with other vaccines.
