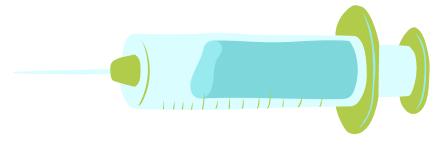


BIVALENT BOOSTER DOSE



WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Based on guidance from Health Canada and the National Advisory Committee on Immunization (NACI), all individuals aged 18+ are eligible to receive the bivalent booster dose, regardless of the number of booster doses previously received.

Bivalent Boosters Available to Vulnerable Populations Immediately, All Ontarians Aged 18+ Eligible Starting September 26, 2022.

Individuals aged 70 and over



Residents of long-term care homes, retirement homes, Elder Care Lodges and individuals living in other congregate settings that provide assisted-living and health services



Moderately to severely immunocompromised individuals aged 12 and over



Pregnant individuals aged 18 and over



First Nation, Inuit and Métis individuals and their non-Indigenous household members aged 18 and over



Health care workers aged 18 and over
