COVID-19 BOOSTER VACCINES AUTHORIZED FOR USE IN ADOLESCENTS 12 TO 17 YEARS OF AGE



The 12 to 17 age group is eligible for the COVID-19 booster dose. The interval between the doses is dependent on the vaccine you receive as well as your health status. However, a minimum interval of 3-6 months is recommended before getting the booster dose.



The Pfizer-BioNTech Comirnaty COVID-19 vaccine has been authorized by Health Canada for individuals 12 years of age and older, using a 30 mcg dose

The Moderna Spikevax COVID-19 vaccine is authorized by Health Canada for individuals 12 years of age and older, using a 50 mcg dose
