LIFTING VACCINE AND MASK MANDATES

As of March 1, 2022, the Ontario government announced that there will be no more proof of vaccination and capacity limits in restaurants, bars, gyms and other indoor venues were lifted Thursday, March 17, 2022. As of March 21, 2022 the mask mandate has also been lifted.

Masks are still mandatory to wear

Masks are no longer a requirement in many settings with the exception of some high-risk areas. However, it is still recommended to wear a mask for extra protection



Masks are still required in the following areas

Public transit, including indoor areas and vehicles



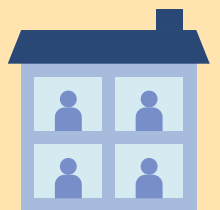
Health care settings
